July 12, 2023

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Peters Township Sanitary Authority was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mr. Hanley reported the status of the PADOT Project – E McMurray and Bebout Road Intersection Improvements. There are meetings schedule with PADOT engineers regarding the cost sharing.

Mr. Hanley reported on the status of the Deerfield Manor/ Links View Drive project. The project is at substantial completion. The swap of Customers will take effect July 1, 2023. Mr. Hanley recommended Ligonier Construction pay application for payment as presented on the capital requisition.

Mr. Hanley reported on the status of the Waterdam Galley Multifamily development. A draft of the proposed cost sharing was sent to the owner/developer. Management recommend approval of HRG's service orders for construction phase engineering services. The public sewer engineering services are paid by the developer escrow. The private sewers will be paid by the Authority. Typically the private sewers inspections are performed by staff through the new tapping permit process however management recommended HRG because of the size and complexity of the development. The Authority will be collecting a large tapping fee for this residential development.
