ORDINANCE NO.

AH URDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PETERS, WASH-INGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 219, PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF VARIOUS PLUMBING FIXTURES AND DEVICES DESIGNED FOR THE PURPOSE OF WATER CONSERVATION AND/OR THE CONTROL OF ORGANIC MATERIALS BEING DISCHARGED INTO THE TOWNSHIP'S SANITARY SEWERS AND TREATMENT FACILITIES; PROVIDING FOR INSPECTION BY DESIGNATED EMPLOYEES OF THE PETERS TOWNSHIP SANITARY AUTHORITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Council of Peters Township, that Section 4 of Ordinance No. 219, adopted by this Council on the 22nd day of September, 1980, needs additional clarification as to the scope of coverage intended,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of Peters Township, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Authority of the same.

SECTION 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 219 be amended to read:

> "Section 4. All restaurants, cafeterias, gasoline service stations, and commercial or industrial garages, grocery stores and all other non-residential operations which generate grease or fats shall install within 180 days of the effective date of this Ordinance, a workable grease trap in the line which conveys their waste to the Township's sewer system. The Peters Township Sanitary Authority shall from time to time prescribe the size and type of trap to be installed in various types of structures. All grease traps shall be cleaned periodically so as to prevent any oil or grease from being discharged into the public sewer system and shall be located in such a manner that they will be readily accessible for inspection. Authorized representatives of the Peters Township Sanitary Authority shall have the authority, at any time during regular business hours of any establishment in which a grease trap is required, to enter the premises for the purpose of inspecting the said grease trap."

SECTION 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be immediately.
