ADOPTING APPENDIX E - RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR WASTEWATER PRETREATMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS, ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE, REPORTING, INSPECTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF VIOLATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Peters Township Sanitary Authority (Authority), is a municipal corporation organized under the Municipal Authorities Act of 1945, for the purpose of providing a sanitary sewer collection, conveyance, and treatment facilities, and for providing the staffing and financing to operate said facilities:

WHEREAS, Authority desires to implement the duties imposed by the Peters Township Ordinance No. 219, September 22, 1980, as amended by Ordinance 232, January 26, 1981.

WHEREAS, the Peters Township Sanitary Authority desires to adopt reasonable Rules and Regulations governing the procedures for installation and maintenance of pretreatment equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Authority hereby adopts Appendix E of the Authority Sewer Use Rules & Regulations, a copy of which is attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, since the Authority is the entity to perform, or cause to be performed, inspections of Food Service Establishments to ensure compliance with the terms of this Resolution, the Authority's Assistant Manager, Special Projects Manager and/or their designated representative be and are hereby authorized to implement procedures and interpret the results under the PTSA "Sewer Use Rules and Regulations Appendix E," to determine when a violation exists, and determine the necessary remedial activities to correct such violation.

Enforcement

Any person, firm, association, company, or organization violating any of the provisions of this Resolution shall be deemed guilty of a summary offense, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined an amount not to exceed the amount of a summary offense. Each day a violation is committed or permitted to continue, after notice of violation, shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.

Conflict with Prior Resolutions

If any section or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid or unenforceable by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validly of the remaining portions hereof.
